

Currently, 48.2% of the 129,231 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 47.7%, renter occupied; and 4.1% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 120,402 housing units in the area - 48.6% owner occupied, 46.4% renter occupied, and 5.1% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 3.20%. Median home value in the area is \$1,293,847, compared to a median home value of \$218,492 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by -0.26% annually to \$1,277,192.
